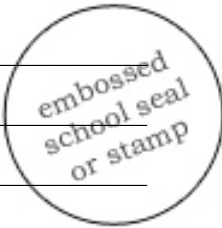

STUDENT INFORMATION

The GRE Fee Waiver Program is funded by income from GRE Test fees. The GRE Program incurs a cost for every test appointment scheduled or test registration received. **DO NOT** schedule an appointment or register for a test unless you are sure you will be able to attend the test session. The long-range viability of the fee waiver program depends on your cooperation in keeping expenses down. We appreciate your help.

In order for this fee waiver certificate to be accepted in lieu of payment for one General Test and/or one Subject Test, it must be

- embossed with an official school seal or stamp and signed by the fee waiver coordinator
- submitted with your Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) if you are a dependent or independent student, or Student Aid Report (SAR) if you are an unenrolled college graduate
- submitted with the proper registration materials

Fee waiver certificates are available only if testing within the United States, a U.S. Territory, or Puerto Rico. The following fees are your responsibility:

- rescheduling
- standby registration (paper-based tests only)
- additional score reports

Your fee waiver certificate materials and registration form(s) must be sent together to GRE in one envelope. This fee waiver certificate is **not** retroactive. If you have already registered, you may use the certificate for a future test during the 2006–2007 testing year. Test fees will **not** be refunded.

If your registration form and appropriate documentation are received without a signed original fee waiver certificate embossed with an official school seal or stamp, it will be returned to you unprocessed. A FAXED CERTIFICATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

If you register but fail to appear on the test date, lose or misplace your fee waiver certificate, or want to repeat a test, you will not be issued another fee waiver.
